#### Biocides: Use and Abuse

#### Chemicals and Coatings in Remediation and Indoor Air Quality: Misunderstandings and Myths

He also provided guidance in the development of Civil Engineering Guide Specification 13281 for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the ASTM E06.23 Committee for the E-1795 ASTM Standard for the Encapsulation of lead-based paint, and as a voting member of the consensus body for the IICRC S520 Mold Remediation standard revision that will be released in September 2008.
